With just 6 weeks from concept to delivery, SUDwell™ produced 900 resin bound railway sleepers each measuring 1400mm x 300mm x 50mm to be installed in a 270m long pathway.

The pathway is an over-ground recreation of the historic Crab and Winkle Line. The original railway has the distinction of being the world's first passenger railway tunnel, completed in 1826.

SUDwell™ collaborated directly with The University of Kent and a well known architect firm to create this stunning celebration of the history of railway and the university.
